Free Community Project Offers Hand-delivered Love Letters for Valentine's Day

San Antonio, Texas – The Briscoe Western Art Museum and San Antonio BCycle have once again partnered on a community Valentine's Day project called *Pony Express Love Letters* intended to spread the love across San Antonio and bring back the art of written correspondence. This free program allows visitors to stop by the Briscoe Museum at 210 W. Market St., San Antonio, Texas 78205 on February 1-12 during normal Museum hours to craft a personal love letter, fill in a Valentine's Mad Lib, and be inspired by books of poetry and famous quotes designed to foster romantic expression. A letter writing station complete with paper, envelopes, and a vintage 1930s Remington typewriter will be set up onsite at the Museum. Each letter will be marked with the Briscoe Museum's very own Pony Express stamp, include discount passes for the Museum and BCycle, and be delivered free of charge!

With the help of San Antonio BCycle, all the collected letters will be delivered to loved ones — by bicycle, like a modern day Pony Express, if they are in the downtown area*— or by postal service outside the boundaries of the BCycle delivery area. everyone to stop by the **Briscoe Museum** (210 W. Market St., 78205) to craft their own Valentine's Day love letter that will be delivered on February 13. A letter writing station complete with inspirational books and ideas will be set up onsite at the Museum between **February 1 - February 12** during normal Museum hours. The project — including use of the letter writing station, supplies and delivery — is FREE of charge and

open to everyone.

Letters: We'll provide the paper and envelopes for your handwritten creations or you can

choose to use our vintage Remington manual typewriter to craft your special note. All letters must include a complete address and full name and will be stamped with the

Briscoe Museum's own Pony Express stamp.

Delivery: All letters located within the geographical boundaries defined by **SA BCycle** will be

hand-delivered by volunteers on bike (includes area between I-35 and I-35/37, up to Josephine and down to Blue Star). All letters outside of the boundaries will be mailed.
