

Is the museum currently offering tours?

The short answer is YES. For the health and safety of both our beloved docents and visitors, we have had to temporarily suspend our docent-led tours. In the meantime, we encourage you to book a self-led tour for your group.

Is it safe to tour the Briscoe at this time?

The museum has taken great care to implement many protocols to preserve the health of our visitors, staff, and volunteers. Firstly, the museum requires that all visitors wear a secure face covering inside the museum and throughout their visit at the Briscoe Western Art Museum.

Upon entry, all visitors will be subject to a temperature screening from our security team to ensure that we are keeping all who enter our building as safe as possible. For a full list of the safety precautions the museum is taking, please visit the Health & Safety page on our website.

When can I bring my group?

Self-led tours of 10 or more may be scheduled any day of the week — Monday through Sunday — during regular business hours. These tours must be scheduled at least three weeks in advance to ensure we remain under 50% of the building's capacity.

How much do tours cost?

Student tours are free. In addition, we offer bus reimbursement for schools in need. For more information, call or email us and ask about the Briscoe Bus Fund.

Adult tours are \$12 per person. Contact the Education & Programs team to see if discounted rates may apply to your group.

How many people can attend a tour?

Groups are limited to 80 students or two school buses, whichever is less. In addition, you need one adult for every 10 students. The museum is currently operating at 50% capacity, which is why it is crucial that you book your visit in advance, so we can ensure that our galleries will allow for social distancing.

How much time does a tour take?

Tours typically last from 45 minutes to one hour.

Where do we park?

Due to the Museum's downtown location, we do not have on-site bus parking. However, we have street side unloading/loading and can provide a list of nearby staging areas that are free. Detailed parking options for buses and chaperones (traveling separately) are outlined in the tour confirmation packet.
