

DIY Barbed Wire

Are you looking for an easy and inexpensive way to add a bit of cowboy flair to your room? Look no further! Barbed wire can help you keep out pesky critters and keep your stick ponies safely corralled. Here's how you can make your own.

Materials

A ball of yarn

Scissors



Step 1: Using the yarn, measure the length of the area where you want to place the barbed wire. Cut two pieces of yarn of this length.

Step 2: Using the length of your finger as a guide, cut several small pieces of yarn.

Step 3: Lay the two long pieces out side by side. Every few inches, tie a short piece onto both of the long pieces of yarn, knotting it securely. You may need to trim the short pieces if they are too long.



Step 4: Hang up your wire by tying it onto posts or by using tape or thumbtacks to apply it directly to the wall.
